IPB University for The Nation

IPB University has a long-standing history. As a part of the University of Indonesia based in Bogor, Faculty of Agriculture in 1940 was the seed for the first agricultural university established in the country. In 1963 this faculty was separated from its parent university in Jakarta and grew as a new university in Bogor under the name Institut Pertanian Bogor (IPB).

IPB has gone through three periods of time: the colonial era, the period of struggle for independence, and the period after the proclamation of independence. Within these three periods, there were consistent values that always existed - striving, nationalism, patriotism, and leadership. These are the values that have always been held firmly from time to time.

The government of Indonesia has assigned IPB to develop tropical agricultural sciences in the country. In the course of time, IPB has developed into a higher education institution having a good reputation and playing an important role in the national development and higher education in Indonesia.

IPB always upholds the principle of providing wide access to high quality education by inviting outstanding high-school students from various background, particularly those from low-economy and rural areas, to study at IPB. The academic-merit based selection system has been implemented since 1976 to ensure the access to as many talented students as possible. In 2011 after being reviewed and evaluated, such a selection system was then adopted to be implemented as the national admission system in all public universities in Indonesia.

The three pillars of Indonesian higher education are education, research, and community service, the third of which was pioneered by IPB University. The introduction of the general education program for first-year students has enabled IPB graduates to develop strong adaptability and play important roles across various fields of life.

The teaching and learning processes at IPB enable the graduates to manage complexities and uncertainties, making them excel in numerical and scalable solutions, training them to always think and act systematically, having them complied with regulations and procedures, encouraging them to always care for farmers, as well as ensuring them to readily help others.

Arrange Your Study at IPB University



How to arrange your study at IPB?

As student exchange

IPB University has established collaborations with numerous universities worldwide, particularly across ASEAN, Australia, Europe, Africa, and the Americas.

In most cases, you do not need to pay tuition fees to IPB University, but you may still be required to pay tuition to your home university. After completing the program, you will receive a certificate, which can support credit transfer.

The program allows you to take undergraduate or graduate courses at IPB University. To apply, you must contact the international office at your home university and follow the exchange program application process before enrolling at IPB University.

Eligibility

- ✓ Completed the 1st year of study at home institution
- ✓ Being an active student with good academic standing at home institution
- ✓ English B2 according to CEFR or IELTS 5.5 - 6.5 or TOEFL 87-109 or equivalent test/certificate, TOEFL-ITP/PBT 550



Application Process

Partner university select and nominate prospective inbound students to IPB.

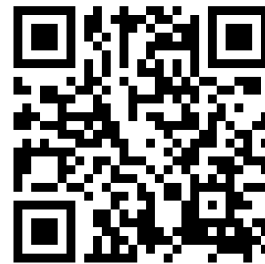
The nominated students fill [the application form](#) and submit their application to [the provided link](#) before the application deadline.

Once inbound students complete the application form, IPB will check student's eligibility followed by issuing the Letter of Acceptance (LoA) and arrange the student visa issuance.

Payment

How much is the monthly dormitory fee?

- The monthly rent is IDR 2,350,000

How is the dormitory fee paid?

- The dormitory fee is paid monthly.
- Payment is based on your check-in date each month.
- For example: If you check in on 6 August, your billing period will be from 6 August to 6 September.
- You will receive a monthly invoice from the dormitory staff.
- The payment deadline is typically 7 days before the due date (H-7).

What are the available payment methods?

You may pay the dormitory fee either:

- In cash directly to the receptionist, or
- Via mobile banking transfer (m-banking) to the following account:

Where and when should I pay?

- You may make your first payment on the next day after your arrival if you arrive at the evening.
- Payments should be made at the dormitory reception desk, which is open from 08.00 to 16.00 local time.

For further inquiries, you may ask the receptionist at Asrama Internasional when you arrive.

Will I get a refund if I leave before the end of the billing period?

- No. The dormitory applies a no-refund policy for early checkouts.

Do I need to sign a contract when checking in?

- No formal contract. You are only required to submit a copy of your passport to the receptionist upon your first payment. Please prepare the document beforehand.

Facilities & Services

Is there a refrigerator and dispenser in the dorm?

- Yes, refrigerators and water dispensers are available on both the 1st and 2nd floors.

Is there a kitchen?

- Yes, there is a shared kitchen available for all dorm residents. Cooking utensils are provided.

How often is the room cleaned?

- Your room will be cleaned twice a week by Asrama Internasional housekeepers.

Is there a curfew?

- The curfew is at 23:00 (11:00 PM). If you plan to return later than that, please notify the security staff in advance.
- Every day, if you plan to leave the dorm, please leave your key in the key drop basket located in the reception lobby.

Living in Bogor, West Java

Bogor has a reputation as "The Rain City" due to its heavy rainfall. In Bogor, the average annual rainfall is extremely high—roughly 3,500–4,000 mm—with the peak occurring in January and an average relative humidity of more than 70%. Bogor experiences tropical rainforest weather like other areas of Indonesia. Bogor's monthly average temperature is 26°C, with lows of 21.8°C and highs of 30.4°C.

The people of Indonesia are pleasant and generally easy to get along with. They come from a wide variety of ethnic backgrounds. You'll discover that most of them respect other cultures.

In **Bogor**, most people communicate in Sundanese (**Bahasa Sunda**). Sundanese is one of the regional languages in West Java, Indonesia.

The cuisine of Indonesia is known for its flavor and spice. The majority of foods contain spices and chillies. The staple food of rice is served with vegetables, tofu, tempeh, and meat, egg, or fish.

As the population of Indonesia is predominantly Muslim, pork is usually not served except in Chinese and non-Moslem restaurants and places serving international cuisine.

It is unsafe to drink tap water. Before drinking, water from the tap should be boiled or sterilized because it can contain bacteria. In almost all grocery stores and convenience stores, bottled water is easily accessible to purchase. Alcohol is only permitted to be consumed in a limited number of places in Indonesia; it is not allowed to be consumed around campus. The legal drink age is 21.

At **IPB University**, students usually dress informally to go to campus. Most of the time, they wear jeans or trousers with casual shirts, blouses, and sneakers. However, shorts and sandals are usually not allowed when attending classes. During the rainy season, a jumper, sweater, pullover, or sweatshirt will be sufficient. Men's suits and appropriate dresses or suits for women are commonly worn in formal functions like a graduation ceremony.

Living in Bogor, West Java

Monthly Utilities

- Electricity and water: IDR 300,000 - 500,000 depending on usage
- Laundry: IDR 10,000 - 20,000 per kilogram. Some accommodation provides laundry facilities.
- Mobile phone 30 days plan: IDR 100,000 - 200,000 for a plan with data, calls, and SMS

Food

- Campus meals: IDR 10,000 - 30,000 per meal.
- Off-campus meals (around Dramaga & Bogor City): IDR 20,000 - 30,000 per meal.
- Local Coffee Shops: IDR 15,000 - 30,000 per drink.
- Franchise restaurants meals: IDR 30,000 - 50,000 per meal.

Transportation

- Taxi/Online Car in Bogor ([Gojek/Grab](#)): IDR 25,000 - 50,000 for a short trip within the city
- Motorbike in Bogor ([Gojek/Grab](#)): IDR 15,000 - 30,000 for a short trip within the city.
- Bus ([BisKita](#), around Bogor City): IDR 3,000 - 5,000 per trip.
- Train (Jabodetabek Commuter Line): IDR 3,000 - 7,000 per trip, depending on the distance.



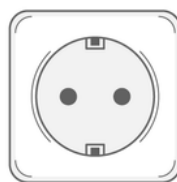

Electronics & Connectivity

- Laptop: Bring your personal laptop if possible.
- Power Plug Type: Indonesia uses Type C or Type F plugs (European two-round-pin).
- Voltage: Standard voltage is 230 V, frequency 50 Hz.
- Travel Adapter: Please bring a universal power adapter if your plug type is different.
- Internet Access: Free Wi-Fi is usually available at campus or hotels. For more stable access, we recommend buying a local SIM card with internet data (available at the airport or convenience stores).
